



The California JPIA's Executive Academy has been created for city managers and agency chief executives and is held over one and a half days in a hotel setting, away from the office.

This academy provides the essential building blocks to develop, establish, and embed risk management as a business process within public agencies. Attendees learn to better manage agency risk by understanding the basic concepts, principles, and applications of risk management. Participants also engage in strategies to strengthen relationships with councils, boards, and department heads; gain a better understanding of the Authority's tools and resources; and learn skills to achieve, create, and support a healthy risk management culture.
