



RISK MANAGEMENT ACADEMY



The California JPIA's Risk Management Academy is held over two and a half consecutive days in a hotel setting.

This academy provides the essential building blocks for developing, establishing, and embedding risk management as a business process within a public agency. Participants also gain a better understanding of the Authority's tools and resources, along with the skills needed to secure buy-in from upper management to create and sustain a healthy risk management culture.

Past topics have included:

- The lifecycle of a workers' compensation claim
- Loss analysis in action
- The liability claims process
- Evidence of coverage
- Authority coverage programs and services

While all California JPIA member employees are welcome to request to register, this academy is for members only and is primarily intended for individuals who serve as their agency's risk manager. There is no cost to attend this members-only academy, and attendees will have the option of staying overnight at the hotel for three nights.
