



## PUBLIC SAFETY ACADEMY



The California JPIA's Public Safety Academy was created specifically for police and fire command staff, providing attendees with information on best practices for managing risk within their public safety departments. Attendees learn how to mitigate risk through enhanced communication with city executives and staff, elected officials, and departmental staff, and to implement a culture of risk management within their department. Additionally, attendees receive tools and resources to better manage risk and understand how the California JPIA can assist in these efforts.

Topics covered at past academies include:

- A guide to the Public Safety Officers Bill of Rights Act
- How to create a fit and healthy workplace culture
- Psychological safety as an organizational norm
- Retaining personnel
- Embracing conflict, safety, and retention for today's work environment
